

COOKIES AND SIMILAR TECHNOLOGIES

FIRSTLY, WHAT ARE COOKIES?

A cookie is a small text file that stores your information such as your font, display, language preference etc and enables basic functions such as page navigation and access to secure areas of the website. The website cannot function as it should without these cookies.

TYPES OF COOKIES

The types of cookies that we use include:

TYPES OF COOKIES	INFORMATION ABOUT THE COOKIES THAT WE USE
Strictly necessary cookies	These cookies are required for the operation of our websites. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our websites, using a shopping cart or use our web applications.
Analytical / performance cookies	They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors to our websites and analyse how visitors move around our websites. This helps us to improve the way our websites work and ensure that the most frequently visited pages are easily accessible.
Functionality cookies	These are used to recognise visitors when they return to our websites. This enables us to ensure that content is personalized, greet you by name and remember your preferences.
Targeting cookies	These cookies record your visit to our websites, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make our website more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose.

3RD PARTY COOKIES

We allow certain third parties to set or access their cookies or similar technologies on your computer or device. These of third party cookies and similar technologies is subject to their own privacy policies.

TYPES OF COOKIES	INFORMATION ABOUT THE USE OF COOKIES
ASP.Net Session	This is used for application management
Company cookie	This cookie contains information about the current selected company
Authentication cookie	Store an authentication token for you as a logged in user
Request verification	Token used for forms to enhance security and prevent cross site scripting attacks
Google analytical cookie	This cookie is used to track user behaviour on the site

CAN I WITHDRAW MY CONSENT?

Once you have given us your consent to use cookies, we store these cookies that expire periodically on your computer or device. If you wish to withdraw your consent at any time, you will need to delete and block our cookies using your internet browser settings.

HOW TO DELETE AND BLOCK OUR COOKIES

You can activate the setting on your browser that allows you to decline the setting of all or some cookies. However, by doing this, you might not be able to access all or part of our site. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will decline cookies, our system will issue cookies as soon you visit our site.

Please note that by turning off or deleting cookies will not prevent device identification and related data collection from occurring.
